Stone Age to Iron Age Day

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are really excited to announce that we have arranged for a member of staff from 'History to Life' to visit school on **Friday 6th October 2023** to lead a 'Stone Age to Iron Age Day' for the Year 3 children which we know will be a fantastic hands-on learning experience.

During the Stone Age Day, the children will learn about the progression from the Stone Age to the Bronze Age to the Iron Age which will support their in-class learning. On this day, they will be provided with first-hand opportunities to learn about life in the Prehistoric era. They will be able to handle artefacts, play games and complete a series of craft and role-play activities, including making mirrors and using charcoal to create cave paintings. The children will be working in groups and the groups will be rotated so that every child has a chance to try every activity. It will be a fun-filled day! In experiencing these activities, children will be consolidating their learning and developing important historical skills.

We are asking for a contribution of £5 per child towards the cost of this visit which includes a full day of activities. Payment can be made via the School Money system or by using the PayPoint slip which can be provided upon request. We really need your help with the funding of this event and hope that you will make the payment at your earliest convenience. If we do not receive funding to cover our costs, these broad, educational experiences, which are so great at helping your children to learn, may not be able to take place in the future.
