<p><b>History:</b></p> <p>Create a fact-file (or an adventure story) about the life of a child during World War 2. This should contain facts about everyday life including evacuation, rationing, the Blitz.</p>	<p><b>Science:</b></p> <p>Electrical invention -tell me more!!</p> <p>Who invented the light bulb, when was it and how does it work?</p>	<p><b>Geography:</b></p> <p>Find out about the countries involved in World War 2 - how and why they were involved.</p>
