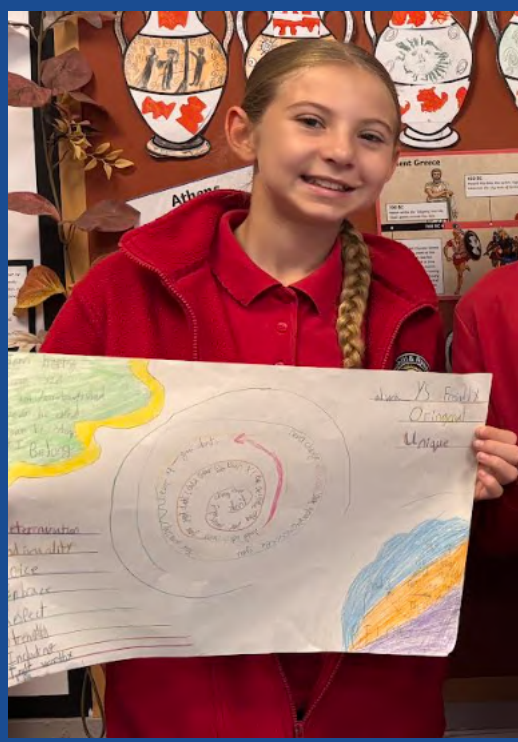

Last Wednesday, some of our children were lucky enough to take part in an exciting sports festival at Herringthorpe Stadium, joining pupils from several other schools.

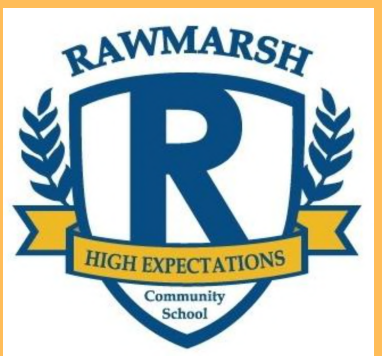
It was a fantastic day of action, giving our young athletes the chance to experience new sports, take risks, and push themselves out of their comfort zones. Every single

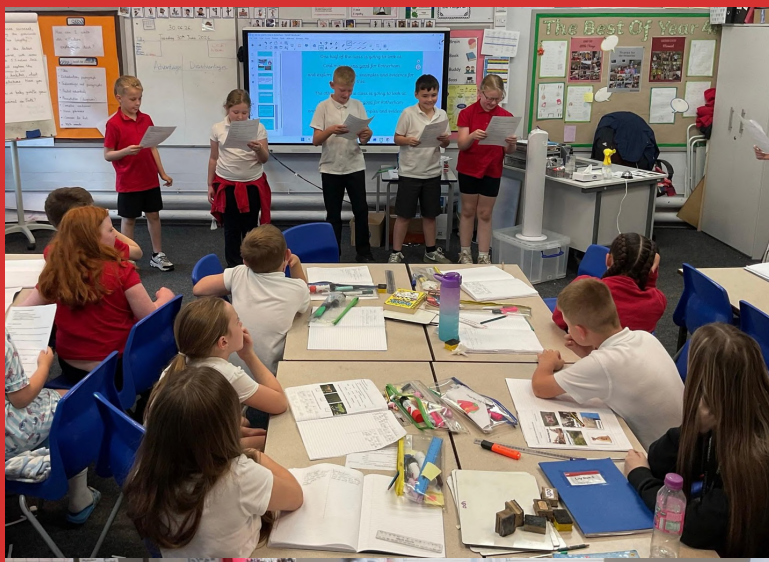

This allowed them to debate the advantages and disadvantages of having a mine in the local area, brilliantly encouraging them to consider and respect different perspectives.
