It was the perfect reward for a fantastic year group. We are incredibly proud of our Year 6 pupils for their fantastic determination and hard work during this year's KS2 SATs! Our school achieved brilliant success across the board, with an outstanding 79.6% of children reaching the expected standard in Mathematics—comfortably exceeding national expectations—and a phenomenal 38.8% of the cohort mastering advanced skills to secure Greater Depth in Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling. Overall, our combined Reading, Writing, and Maths score reached 63.3%, successfully rising above the national average of 63%. Behind these wonderful percentages are inspiring stories of individual growth, with every single student making remarkable progress from their Year 6 starting points. A massive thank you to our dedicated staff and to you, our wonderful parents and carers, for your unwavering partnership and support in making these achievements possible!
